

Competition Brief

Competition title

Inclusive Basic Wood Working

Competition overview

Duration of competition is 3 hours.

Competitors will be required to measure, mark out and form some basic joints to create a basic box and lid that can be used (competitors will take the completed task home at the end of competition)

Competitors will also be required to mark out 2 halving joints and present for marking before forming the joint by the use of hand tools only.

Entry criteria

The competition is for learners working at Entry Level 3.

A statement of support that outlines any individual needs of the participant within the competition must be submitted along with entry form.

Number by location/organisation

Capacity of 12 competitors per heat. Up to 2 per location and up to a maximum of 3 per organisation

Brief

Competitors will be required to measure, mark out and form some basic joints to create a basic box and lid that can be used. They will also be required to produce two halving joints. They will be marked on the neatness, accuracy of the work and safe working practices.

Competitors are expected to bring their own tools. Work benches, vices and bench hooks will be supplied at venue.

Competition rules

Competition specific rules

- Contestants will start and finish work as instructed by the judges
- Contestants must respect the safety rules.
- The use of any electrical tool is forbidden. Only professional hand tools shall be used.

- Contestants will manage their time in order to complete the box within the allocated time. It is strongly recommended to perform the assembling and the gluing of the parts before the morning break, so that the contestants may then remove the clamps and complete their work.
- If any defects are found, contestants can have the parts replaced before the beginning of the competition. Two (2) points shall be deducted for any replacements requested once the competition has begun. Furthermore, contestants may only request the replacement of 1 parts maximum.
- Contestants are allowed to use a quick-setting glue.
- The jury will inspect the contestants' toolboxes before the competition. Any tool that give a clear advantage to its user will be removed.
- If during the competition a contestant feels they must leave their work (e.g. medical reasons, toilet break), they will have the time recorded on a 'time out' sheet by a member

Generic competition rules

- Mobile phones to be switched off during competition activity.
- Listening to music via headphones is not permitted during competition activity.
- Any questions during competition activity should be addressed to the competition judging panel.
- Competitors should not communicate with other competitors during competition activity.
- It is the responsibility of each competitor to arrive on time for each competition session. No additional time will be allowed if you arrive late.
- Technical failure of your equipment should be reported immediately to the judging panel. Additional time will be allocated if the fault is beyond the control of the competitor.
